

Conditionality for Certification of Completion of Under-Graduate Courses

Course	Necessary Conditions for Successful Completion of the Course and Certification	
Honours	H 1	The Student passes in each and every Compulsory paper
	H 2	The Student passes in each and every elective paper
	H 3	The Student secures in aggregate at least 45% of marks in Honours papers (opted by him/her) taken together (not necessarily in each and every Honours papers)
	Further, it is clarified that for a student to obtain Honours it is necessary to pass (i.e., obtain at least 30% marks) in each of the compulsory, elective as well as Honours papers, but it is not necessarily to secure 45% marks in each Honours papers. This percentage (i.e., 45%) will be computed at the End Semester.	
Honours with Simple Pass	HP 1	The Student passes in each and every Compulsory paper
	HP 2	The Student passes in each and every elective paper
	HP 3	The Student secures in aggregate not less than 33% but less than 45% of marks in the Honours papers (chosen by him/her) taken together (not necessarily in each of the Honours papers).
	Further, it is clarified that for a student to obtain Honours with Simple Pass it is necessary to pass (i.e., obtain at least 30% marks) in each of the compulsory as well as Honours papers. However, the students must secure not less than 33% but less than 45% marks in the Honours papers all taken together. These percentages (i.e., 33% and 45%) will be computed at the End Semester.	
Fail	F 1	If a student shall be declared to have 'failed' if he/she Fails to secure at least 30% of marks in any of the compulsory, electives (1 or 2) or Elective Honours, or
	F 2	Fails to secure 33% marks in aggregate
